THIS WEEK WE ACCOMPLISHED:

- We learned the sounds for: v, y, x, oo. Please continue to practice daily all of the sounds and letter names.
- We learned the Tricky Words: we, me, like.
- Some stations included: completing a Boogly writing activity (hanging in room); listening to a Halloween story at the listening station; completed a color scarecrow booklet and a number booklet; we found words in the room beginning with g-h-o-s-t and b; used letter dice to practice letter recognition and sounds; used a feely box to find different given objects; practiced our graphing skills using different objects; painted a pumpkin with marshmallows; made a spider out of a gum tree seed; completed a spider sequence; made a spider headband; and completed a spider counting game.
